moving forward:

Intentionalize some time, every day this week, to stop and behold Jesus as the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. Think about what it means that God has come for us, to be with us and what it means that He would come in this way.

Read through Isaiah 53 each day this week. Reflect on what it meant for those it was originally written to and then on what it means to us, on this side of Christmas.
